

The IEEE Sensors Council Web Editor-in-Chief and Webmaster are appointed by the Sensors Council President.

The Web Editor-in-Chief shall have overall responsibility for the Sensors Council website. The Webmaster shall be responsible for maintaining the website, and shall be the only one authorized to change the website. The Webmaster shall receive instructions, and the information to be placed on the website, only from the Web Editor-in-Chief, and, when the Editor-in-Chief is unavailable, from the Sensors Council VP for Publications.

The officers of the Sensors Council shall oversee and provide the information for the pages within their areas of responsibility. Requests for changes to the website shall be transmitted to the Web Editor-in-Chief who will review the request prior to forwarding it to the Webmaster.

The website shall include information of general interest - to be provided primarily by the officers, Sensors Journal editor-in-chief, standing committee chairs, etc. The website shall include information on upcoming and past Sensors Council conferences, Sensors Journal special issues, governance, awards, historical information, distinguished lecturer program, review and tutorial papers, and other information of interest to the Sensors Council and sensors community.
