1. Proposed Citation and Basis for Nomination (not exceeding 2 pages):

- (a) Provide a **Proposed Citation** not exceeding 50 words, giving the major accomplishments for which, the award is being made. This will be used if the nominee is selected as the awardee.
- (b) Followed by a **Nomination Statement** not exceeding 750 words on why the candidate is being nominated for this award.
- (c) Followed by **The record of Accomplishments** of the candidate as an educator, researcher, administrator, or industrial pioneer

2. Biography of the candidate (not exceeding 2 pages):

Include degrees earned (list universities and granting dates); other postgraduate study; record of all positions held (chronologically starting with the most recent position); IEEE activities and offices; other society memberships and offices; awards, honors, five most important publications, patents, inventions and other relevant contributions. (Email as separate attachment, if necessary). (NOTE: A database link may be supplied as a means to supply the list of all the publications and awards and stay within the page limit.)

3. References:

The nominator should collect and submit up to five letters of reference with the nomination package.
